The **Keoladeo National Park** at **Bharatpur** is a famous avifauna sanctuary that sees thousands of rare and highly endangered birds such as the **Siberian Crane** come here during the **Winter Season**. Over 230 species of birds are known to have made the **National Park** their home.

The sanctuary is also inhabited by mammals such as **Sambar**, **Chital Deer** and **Nilgai Antelope** that are preyed upon by **Jackal** and **Wild Dog**. There are also large herds of **Wild Boar**.
